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The Newington Neighbourhood Plan is a plan for the Anlaby Road area in the vicinity of the MKM Stadium and will be the first neighbourhood plan in the city if it is voted in at a forthcoming referendum and will sit alongside Hull City Council's Local Plan for the City.

The West Hull Cultural Strategy aims to put culture at the heart of this plan to help create 'A Neighbourhood of Culture' utilising existing partnerships, organisations, and past venues in the area, such as Giroscope, The Vulcan Centre, and Lonsdale Community Centre alongside parks and ex-cinemas to act as a catalyst for change and regeneration.



WHAT WILL IT BE?

The West Park Palace is one of Hull's old early 20th Century picture houses, built during the golden age of cinema in 1914. Known back then as the West Park Palace, we propose to revive its original name and status as an iconic local building located in the South East of Hull, turning it into a multi-functional arts and community space/ cafe.

Adjacent will also be a new open green space / public art garden on the corner of Perry St, for visitors to enjoy and also attend outdoor events.

ITS HISTORY.

The West Park Palace has undergone multiple developments and changes through its 100 year lifetime and as mentioned the former picture house first **opened in 1914 as a 742 seat cinema** known as **The West Park Palace**, or more locally as **West Park Cinema**.

The cinema industry however then declined and West Park Palace was forced to close in 1959, leading to the building's redevelopment as social clubs and sports bars, before sadly **closing for good in 2007 and lying empty since**.
